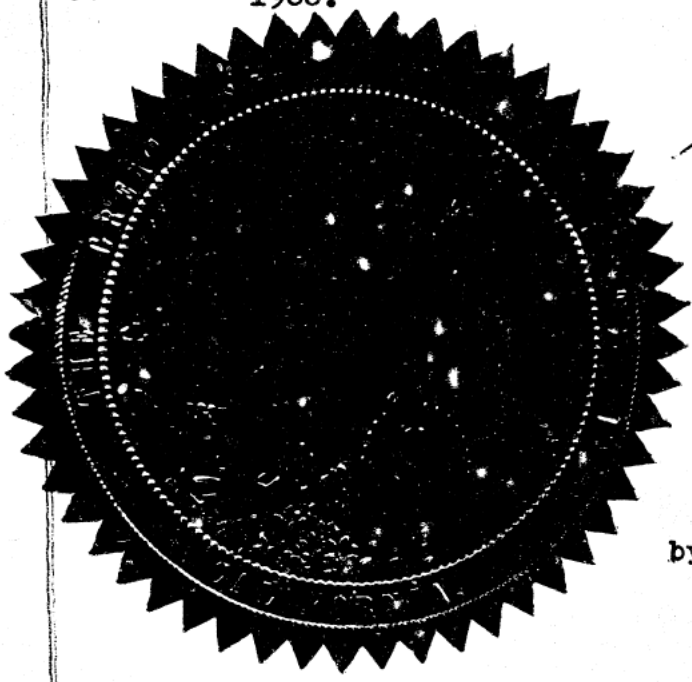
PROCLAMATION OF EXTREME EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, having found that a condition of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within this State resulting from the riot within the County of *SAN FRANCISCO* and having found that local authority is inadequate to cope with this peril and having found that such condition is by reason of its magnitude beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the City of *SAN FRANCISCO* and the County of *SAN FRANCISCO* therefore proclaim a state of extreme emergency in the County of *SAN FRANCISCO*.

I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately, and that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of California; and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
